

## READING LESSON

### ❖ Introducing New Vocabulary

- Listen, read and pronounce each word a couple of times
- Define vocabulary
  - Pictures, charades, dictionary, pantomiming or first language
- Write and read a sentence using the word (teacher) for better understanding
- Practice pronunciation as a whole in small groups and individually in order and random order
  - Practice reading and defining words with partners using pantomime or pictures or however they can remember
- Play a game – two teams one team defines word by using a sentence, pantomiming, ect. Member of other team has to guess the word
- Make prediction by looking at the pictures
- Teacher reads story students listen and clap when they hear any of the vocabulary words that were introduced
- Echo reading sentence by sentence, they first listen to teacher, then read
- Choral reading
- Read with partners (take turns listening and reading)
- Discuss their predictions
- Check comprehension by answering true and false questions provided by teacher (easy way due to lack of Eng.)
- Use pictures provided by story and assign in groups to make sentences with the pictures or short story. Depending on the level of English
